Should there be a tie after the last competition, it will be broken as follows: a. The ranks of the max. three (3) counting exercises will be added and the gymnast with the lowest total prevails. Note: in case of a tie in the ranks to determine the three counting exercises, the exercises with the highest final scores will prevail. b. If the tie remains, the final scores of the max. three (3) counting exercises will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails. c.
