Judges	All participating judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG). The participating Member Federations must provide minimum one qualified judge as mentioned above. Failure to do so will result a fine of 150,00€ - to be paid to the LOC upon arrival.

Visa	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Greece Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Greece. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that Visa request is made before January 15th, 2024 to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Members as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.					

Insurance	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any				
	liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.
